PAUL LAFLEUR ENJOYS CRUISING THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS WITH FRIENDS AND FAMILY.

Paul LaFleur’s parents chartered a sailboat 30 years ago in the British Virgin Islands and haven’t stopped talking about it since. “They told me it was one of the greatest trips of their lives and said I needed to go see for myself,” says Paul, a Gulfport, Mississippi-based strategic account manager for SunBelt Rentals. But it wasn’t until after one of Paul’s customers returned from a MarineMax Vacations trip in the BVI that he took his parents’ advice.

Paul grew up boating and owns a 26-foot Blackjack center console bay boat to fish and cruise the coastal and inshore waters of the Florida Panhandle, but he had no charter experience. “After my first inquiry [to MarineMax Vacations], they called me back within 24 hours and provided lots of information,” says Paul and adds that he spoke with a lot of customers who had been on the trip previously.

“Then, a month or two before the trip, they sent videos and additional information about the boat’s generator, toilet, and grey water procedure that I could share with my wife and the other couple we invited. We all knew what to expect.”

Paul’s group flew to St. Thomas in the U.S. Virgin Islands and took the high-speed ferry to Nanny Cay, where they stayed for the night prior to their departure the next day. “Our expectation was already really high, and our excitement for the trip built over dinner at Peglegs,” Paul recalled. Their overnight location was close to the MarineMax base for their 11 a.m. orientation the next morning, which Paul describes as very thorough. They also recorded the entire presentation so that they could revisit it later if needed.

The MarineMax 443 power catamaran they chose gave them plenty of room for their weeklong charter. An employee from the base operations guided their vessel out of the slip toward the harbor entrance and jumped off at the fuel dock.

The first leg of their itinerary was to the west side of Tortola, where they picked up a mooring ball in Cane Garden Bay for the evening.

“We had drinks and dinner on the boat, and just relaxed to get familiar with the generator, but they came over within an hour to fix the generator and changed the fuel filter.” Paul added that they didn’t have another problem with it the rest of the trip.

According to Paul, every island in the BVI has its own appeal and it’s difficult to say which is his favorite although Paul claims Great Dog is probably the 2nd or 3rd best snorkeling place he’s ever been. The seas on their cruise to Anegada were rough, but the boat handled really well, and the lobster dinner ashore was well worth the trip. He’ll never forget Virgin Gorda with the boulders at The Baths, and Cooper Island was where he saw a sea turtle for the first time.

“We spent two nights there because there was so much sea life—big barracudas, tarpon, conch, plus at least 30 sea turtles throughout the time we were there!”

Their last day was memorable at Peter Island and aboard the Willie T (now located at Norman Island). “We walked the plank and jumped off like everyone does,” Paul says about the infamous BVI tradition. “Mooring at Norman Island set us up for an easy journey back to the base the next morning and to fuel up.”

Fuel economy was one of the many aspects that impressed Paul about the MarineMax 443 and says it didn’t burn nearly as much fuel as they expected. In addition to comfortable beds and air conditioning for restful sleep, the onboard amenities were more than what they anticipated. “We used the grill several nights and the underwater lights attracted tarpon, which were fun to watch. We didn’t even turn on the TV!” Paul’s entire group feels the cost of the trip is a great value for the money. “They put a million-dollar boat in your hand and prepare you to use it. The boat was a couple of years old and in great shape. Everything worked and if it didn’t, they were there very quickly. We ran both our engines and generator the whole time and burned less than 125 gallons of diesel for seven days.”

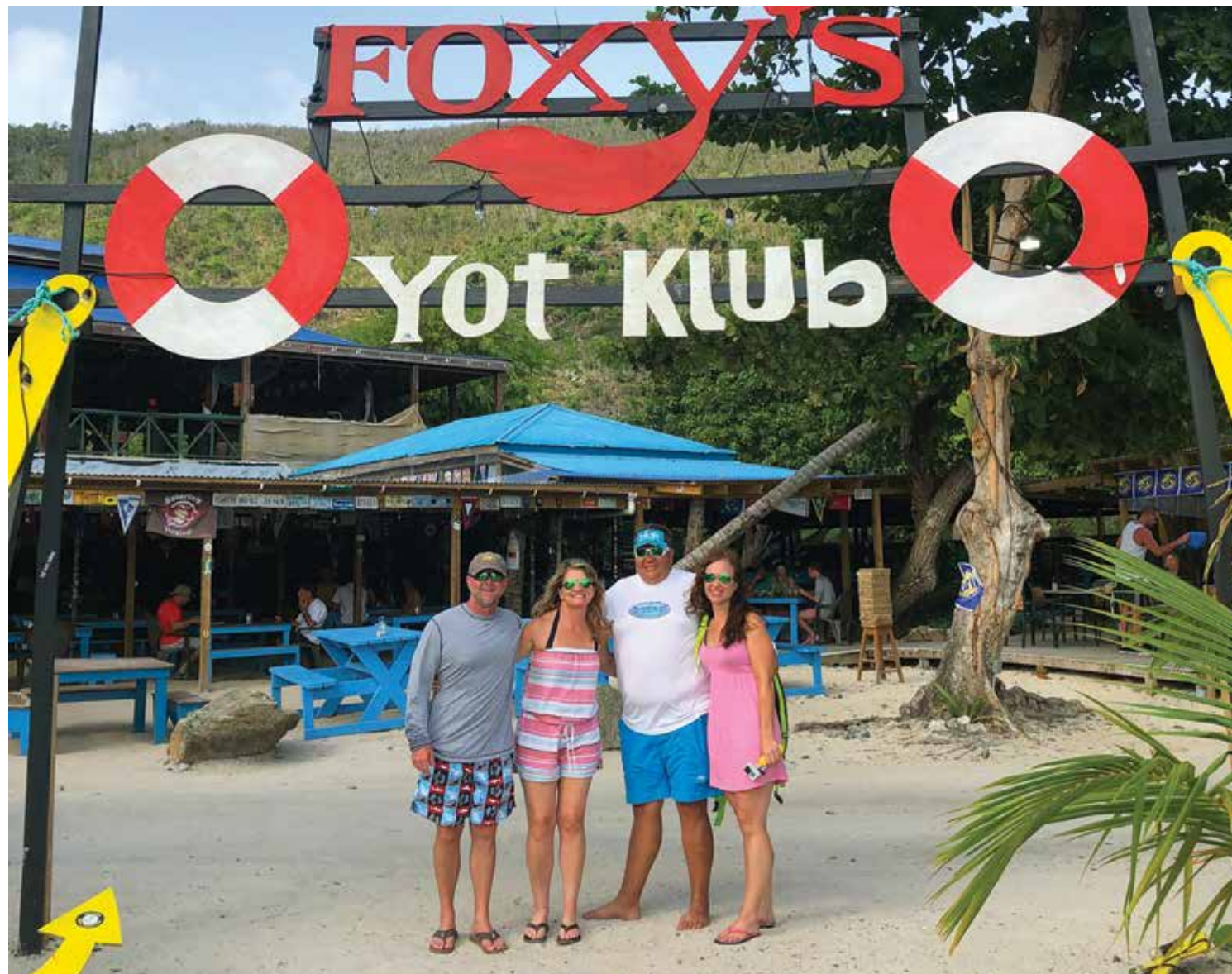
As a first-time charterer, Paul says his experience with MarineMax Vacations could not have been better.

They’ll also

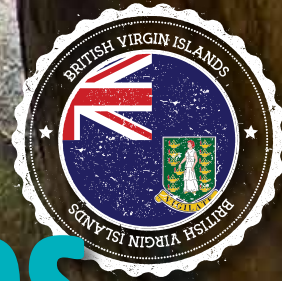

HOW

To Get There

Located just east of Puerto Rico, the British Virgin Islands are served by multiple airlines and ferries depending on your location. Your MarineMax Vacations planning expert can assist with questions regarding the logistics of your travel situation. Don't forget you'll need a passport to clear customs at arrival and departure.



ARRIVING

By Plane

One option for U.S. travelers to the British Virgin Islands (BVI) is to arrive into Puerto Rico at the Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (airport code SJU), often flying directly from almost a dozen U.S. airports. Connections from San Juan into the BVI airport - Terrance B. Lettsome International Airport (airport code EIS) are then available on airlines such as Seaborne, InterCaribbean, Cape Air, and LIAT.



ARRIVING

By Ferry

If you fly into the St. Thomas airport, you have the option of taking the ferry to Tortola by taking a taxi from the airport to the ferry dock. The ferries typically run during daylight hours and tickets may be purchased at the dock prior to departure.

SHUTTLE

In Tortola

Once you arrive in Tortola, shuttles are available from both the airport and the ferry dock to take you to your hotel. As residents of a British territory, shuttle drivers speak English. Your MarineMax Vacations planning expert can handle your transfer tickets and reservations, so you can enjoy worry-free travel.



PROVISIONING

Your MarineMax Vacations planning expert will assist you with making sure you have the provisions you desire on your boat before your arrival. Or, you may choose to shop upon your arrival. If you provision your boat through MarineMax Vacations, we will send you an order sheet in advance and work with our local vendor to stock your boat with the items you request. A small grocery store is onsite at Nanny Cay Marina and Resort for any last minute items you may need. Throughout your charter there are options for replenishing your supplies on various islands.

You can also choose to dine out during your charter. Most destinations have restaurants and bars where you can enjoy delicious meals of local fare.

WEATHER

It's a tropical paradise with an ideal climate with tradewinds and plenty of sunshine. Daytime temperatures average 80 – 85 degrees, and nighttime temperatures are typically 75 – 80 degrees.

Sandy Cay

DAY 1

Arrive in the British Virgin Islands via ferry from St. Thomas or a flight into Beef Island, take a deep breath, and relax. Enjoy an evening soaking in the scenery before starting off on your charter in the morning.

DAY 2

After completing your boat briefings, it's time to head off into the crystal-clear waters of the Caribbean for your first destination - The Baths on Virgin Gorda. These enormous boulders are a sight to see and a great spot for snorkeling. Head to the Top of the Baths Restaurant for a stunning view and enjoy lunch. From here, Leverick Bay makes a great stop for the evening. Mooring balls are available, and Leverick Bay offers a restaurant, pool, grocery, entertainment, and spa.



Anegada Island

DAY 3

Once you arrive at Leverick Bay, you can discover the best of North Sound from wonderful anchorages to fine restaurants and resorts. Experienced cruisers may choose to navigate to Anegada Island where you can snorkel, visit tiki bars and dine on the famous Anegada lobster. Cars and scooters are available for rent so you can explore the island and all that it has to offer. It's known for secluded beaches like Loblolly Bay and Cow Wreck Beach as well as waterside restaurants.

DAY 4

After Anegada, head to Scrub Island Resort, Spa & Marina to enjoy lunch and a dip in their two pools. In the afternoon, make your way to Jost Van Dyke for an overnight stay in Great Harbour. Along the way you can stop at Monkey Point to snorkel. Dinner can be enjoyed at Foxy's in Great Harbour.

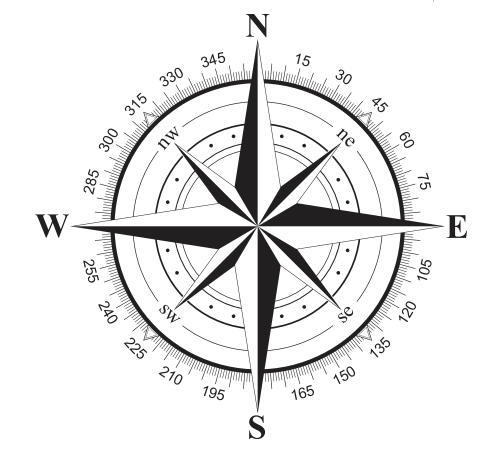
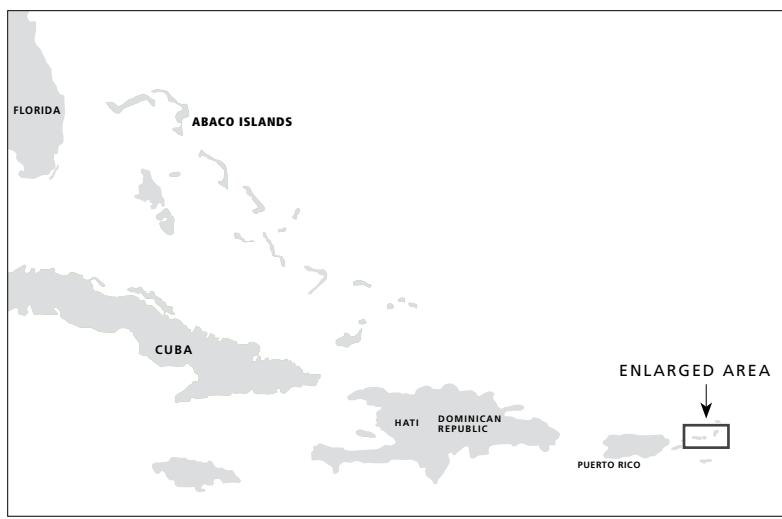
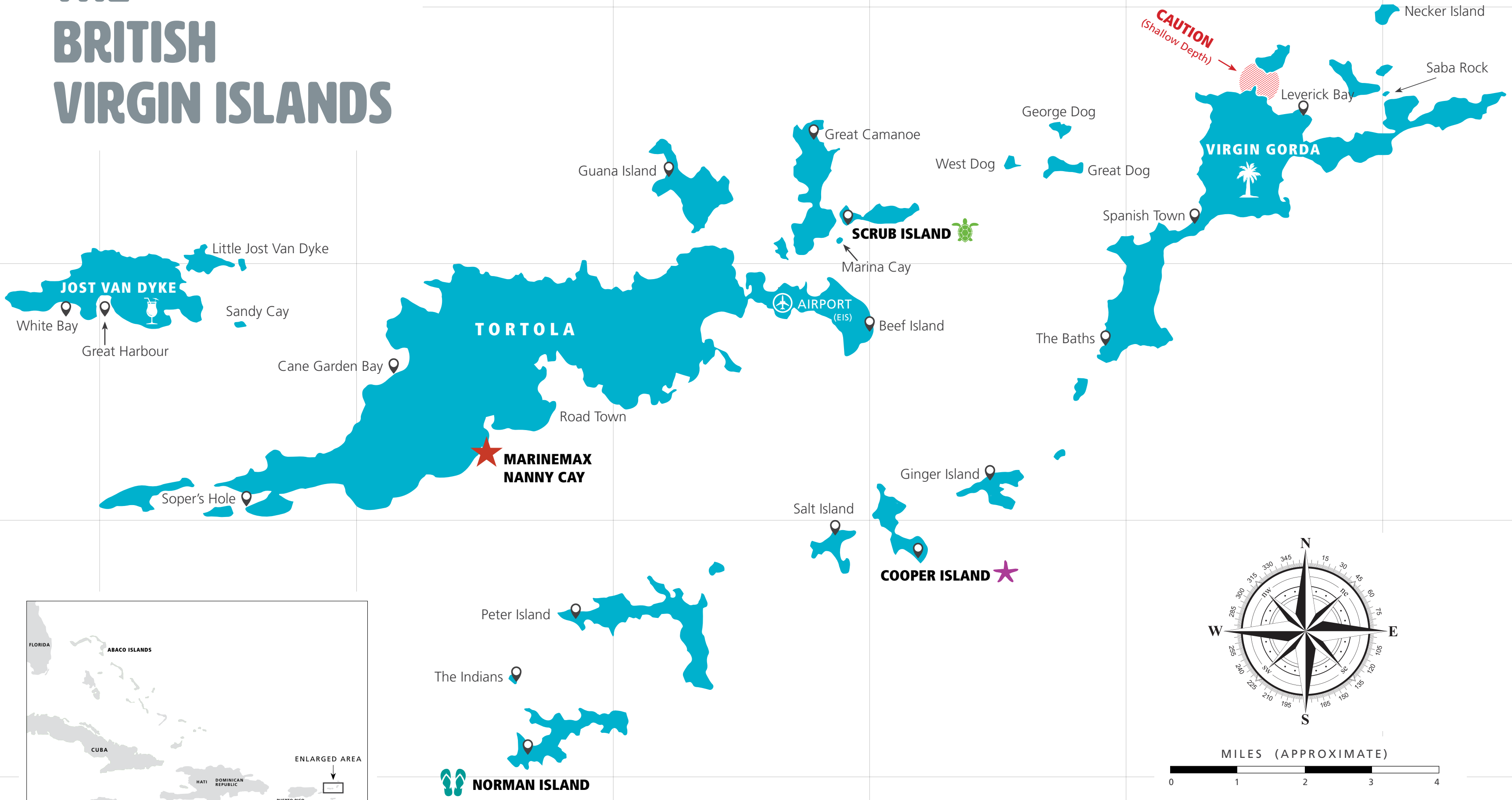


DAY 7

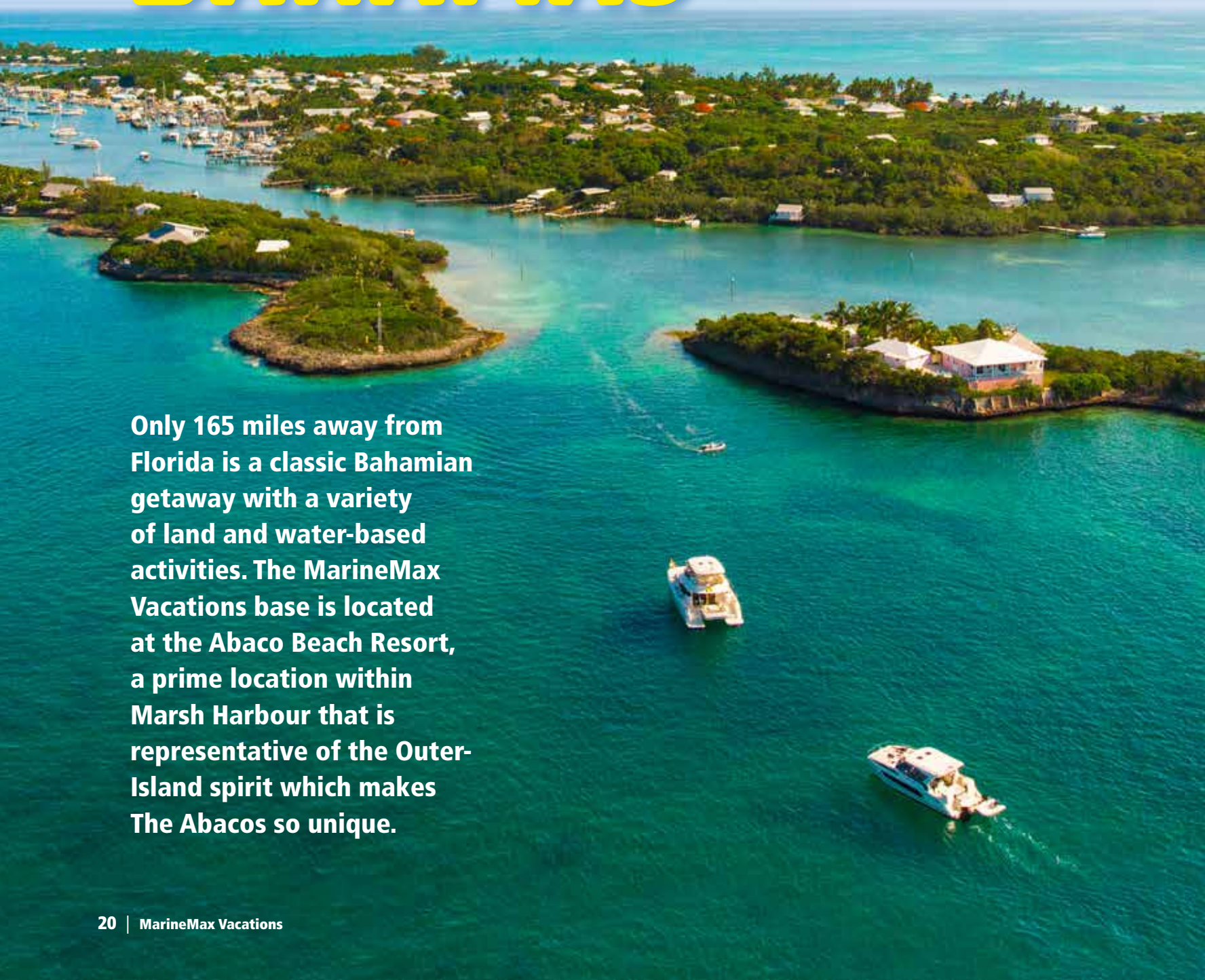
THE BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

BAHAMAS



Only 165 miles away from Florida is a classic Bahamian getaway with a variety of land and water-based activities. The MarineMax Vacations base is located at the Abaco Beach Resort, a prime location within Marsh Harbour that is representative of the Outer-Island spirit which makes The Abacos so unique.



Just a short trip off the coast of Florida, Abaco Beach Resort sits on 40-beachfront acres and is home to one of the largest marinas in the Bahamas with 198 slips. The resort caters to families, couples, friends, and groups looking to escape the crowds of some of the larger islands. Two dining options are onsite – Angler’s Restaurant and the Pool Bar

which also offers swim-up seating by day and live entertainment by night. Other amenities found at Abaco Beach Resort include two outdoor swimming pools, a fitness center, tennis facilities, yoga, a volleyball court, and non-motorized water-sporting equipment like kayaks, bogy boards, and snorkeling gear.





Is a passport needed to travel to the Bahamas?

Yes, you will need a passport to travel to the Bahamas. You will also need to clear customs upon entering the Bahamas and again on your journey back to your country of origin.

What should you bring on your trip?

Bathing suits, shorts, and your favorite casual beach attire is best. Rubber soled shoes such as boat shoes, sandals, and tennis shoes are also recommended. Some guests have been happy to have aquatic shoes when beachcombing the islands. Most importantly, don't forget to pack the sunscreen, wide-brimmed hats, and even a windbreaker comes in handy in the breezy evenings.



HOW

To Get There

The Leonard M. Thompson International Airport (MHH airport code), located in Marsh Harbour offers easy travel to our base. Major airlines serving this airport include Delta, American, Bahamas Air, and Silver Airways. Direct, non-stop service is available from Atlanta and most major airports in Florida including Fort Lauderdale, Miami, and West Palm Beach. Guests can also fly direct from Nassau or via a number of charter services. Taxis are available upon exiting the airport and will take you to Abaco Beach Resort.

PROVISIONING

Maxwell's Supermarket is on the way as you travel from the airport to Abaco Beach Resort, a great stop for stocking your boat for your trip. Delivery service is not yet available in Marsh Harbour. Alcoholic beverages are available at Jimmy's Wine and Spirits, a short walk from the resort, or there are additional options along your trip from the airport to the base.



WEATHER

With calm waters and warm breezes, you'll find the weather to be similar to southern Florida. Daytime temperatures average around 85 degrees in the summer and 75 degrees in the winter, with temperatures dropping 10-15 degrees at night. The coolest time is between December and April, with July and August being the hottest months and May and June seeing the most rainfall.

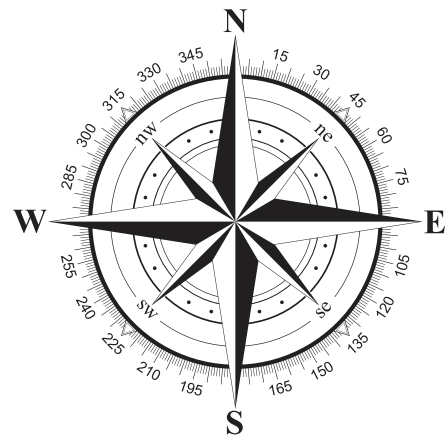
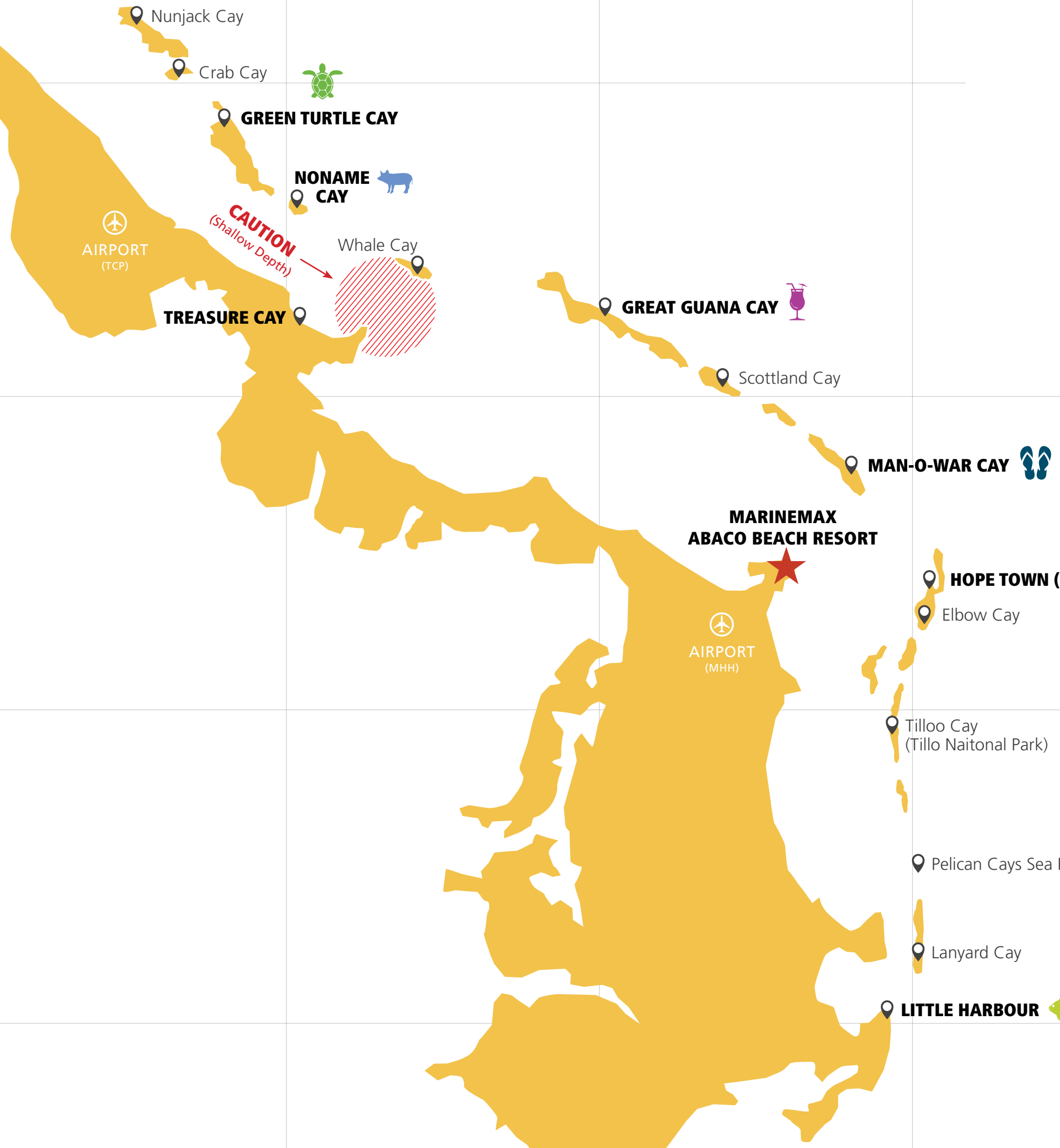
DAY 6

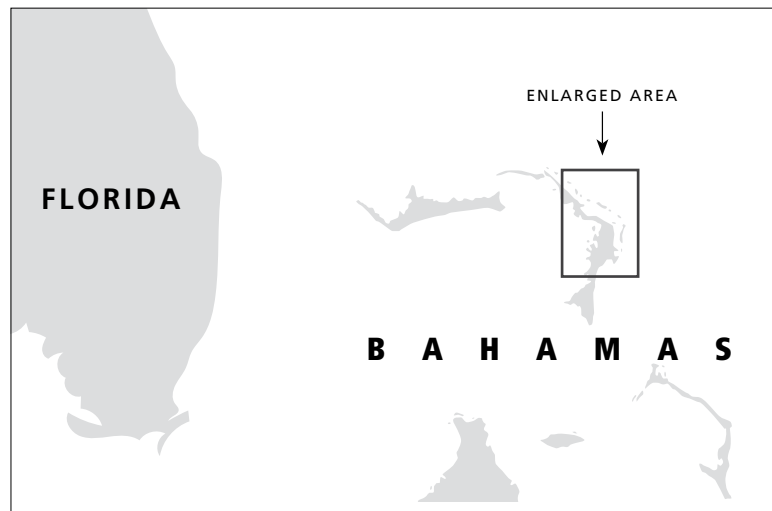
